We are pleased to welcome you back to Taiko Center of the Pacific IN PERSON classes!

Though the pandemic situation in Hawai'i has improved, we want to stay vigilant and practice safety. To participate in IN PERSON classes, please note the following:

Any and All persons participating in IN PERSON classes (students, teachers, staff) are required to:

1. Provide proof of full vaccination and booster.
2. If not vaccinated, provide proof of a negative covid test result taken within 48 hours of coming to the dojo.
3. If you are not feeling well, have a fever or cough, please refrain from coming to class.
4. Please immediately notify Taiko Center of the Pacific if you tested positive for Covid.
5. Wash / sanitize hands with alcohol-based solution immediately upon entering the classroom.
6. Face masks must be worn at all times while in the classroom, regardless of vaccination status.
7. Face masks must cover the entire nose and mouth while in use.
8. Masks may only be removed when alone in a private room with the door closed (restroom) or when drinking water.
9. Four to six feet social distancing between individuals is recommended while in the classroom.
10. Gathering areas in the classroom should be avoided.
11. Refrain from sharing bachi (drumsticks).
12. NO food shall be consumed in the classroom.
13. For those helping to restore equipment at the end of the day, please wash/sanitize hands before putting
Preparing equipment for storage.
14. You will be notified if there may have been Covid exposure during your time at TCP.
15. The confidentiality of any infected individuals and those being notified of exposure will be maintained at all time.
16. Registration and Liability Form must be signed and submitted no later than the 1st day of classes.
17. Online students must also submit a Zoom Approval form no later than the 1st day of classes.
18. No observers (including parents, family members, friends) are permitted in the classroom.

Parking

FREE parking is available in the school's parking lot fronting King Street.

FREE parking is available in the school's rear parking lot (enter from Philip Street). You may park by the dumpsters or near the cafeteria.

Students and Parents are NOT to drive up to or park in front of the Band Room (exception: if you are transporting TCP drums or equipment to be loaded/unloaded).

Please refrain from driving on the grass.
